The verb, "to give," occurs 17 times in Jesus' prayer in John 17 and more often in John than in any of the other gospels (Morris, p. 718, note 6). It puts the focus on God's grace. Then Jesus defines eternal life, drawing together verses 1 and 2 (John 17:3): "This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."
