But instead of leading, you toprope the climb and practice clipping the monkey-tail through each fixed draw. When your monkey game is solid, take your gym's lead class, then pass the lead test.

Step 1. Clip your rope through a quickdraw on one of the anchor bolts. Step 2. Clip another quickdraw into the other anchor bolt and clip it directly to your belay loop. Rest your weight on this quickdraw. Step 3. Pull up a little slack and push a bight of the rope through the main anchor point as shown. Step 4.

This setup can work for everything from building a climbing anchor to making your own adjustable personal anchor system (PAS). Self-belay loop: Use a 2- to 3-foot length of 5 - 8mm Perlon cord tied in a loop with a double fisherman's knot. This is a good length to make an autoblock hitch or prusik hitch to use as a backup brake while rappelling.

For cragging, where anchors are usually fixed 30 meters off the ground, get a 60-meter rope. Many newer routes, however, might have anchors at 35 or 40 meters, making a 70- or 80-meter rope mandatory. Pay attention to route length, and make sure your rope is long enough.

Sport climbing is the act of ascending a face that has been pre-equipped with bolts anchored into the rock or gym wall. As you climb, you clip a rope into a quickdraw for protection. The goal of sport climbing is to reach the top without falling or resting on any bolts.

### **How to Climb: Types of Climbing, from Bouldering to Trad**

A climbing anchor is a small tool that weighs 5 kilograms. It is a long metal rod which, when driven firmly into the ground, creates an anchor point for a strand to be attached. Once primed, a climbing anchor combined with a strand can allow someone to safely ascend and descend steep slopes and cliffs.
