Program: Any set of related activities undertaken to achieve an intended outcome; any organized public health action. At CDC, program is defined broadly to include policies; interventions ...

Lets start with this part of evaluation: "...the systematic assessment" An evaluation is a systematic assessment. Evaluations should follow a systematic and mutually agreed on plan. Plans will typically include the following: Determining the goal of the evaluation: What is the evaluation question, what is the evaluation to find out.

### answer to this question: What is program evaluation?

Evaluation includes getting ongoing feedback, e.g., from the learner, trainer and learner's supervisor, to improve the quality of the training and identify if the learner achieved the goals of the training. ... The ROI process model provides a systematic approach to ROI calculations. ... These values are readily available in most organizations ...

### Evaluating Training and Results (ROI of Training)

The strategy-evaluation system should be: directed to the right persons who really matter in taking actions based on data.
