Expository Essay Structure. As a rule, expository writing is done in MLA format and typically has a standard 5-paragraph essay structure: Paragraph 1: Introduction with a hook to grab your readers' attention, and a thesis statement that clearly presents the main concept and goal of your paper.

Typically, essays such as the expository essay are based on a 5 paragraph format, which is roughly one paragraph of introduction, three main points making up the body of the essay, and a one-paragraph conclusion.
