Patients with implants have an artificial, titanium tooth root surgically implanted in their jaw. Once the implant fuses with the bone through a process called osseointegration, an artificial tooth (crown) can be placed where a natural tooth is missing. The majority of implants are successful.

Silicone implant rupture that doesn't cause any noticeable symptoms is known as "silent rupture." Screening for breast implant rupture. The FDA recommends that people with silicone breast implants receive MRI screening for "silent rupture" 3 years after the initial implant surgery and every 2 years after that.
